Safest Fleet Award Winner *Marten earns recognition for second straight year*

Marten Transport was awarded the 2022 Safest Truckload Fleet in Wisconsin by the Wisconsin Motor Carriers Association. This is Marten's second consecutive year being awarded this prestigious award.

To be eligible for the award companies must have an accident ration of 3.0 or less and report only miles and accidents occurring in Wisconsin.

Thanks to our Marten Team we had an accident ratio in 2021 of 0.021 with 20,719,196 miles

driven! That is an incredible statistic. At Marten, safety is our number one priority. We invest in experienced drivers and install the best technology in our trucks to support our drivers.

It is an honor to be recognized for the second year running by the Wisconsin Motor Carriers Association for our efforts in keeping our drivers and other motorists safe on the roads.

SAFETY

Important Winter Driving Tips

Winter weather is headed our way. Here are a few tips for driving in inclement weather.

• Slow down – Most at fault accidents are due to excessive speed. Driving at the speed limit may be legal but is often too fast for snow covered or icy road conditions. DO NOT HURRY.

• Keep a safe following distance – Leave plenty of room between your vehicle and the vehicle in front of your truck, and beside your truck.

• Don't travel as part of a pack – Traffic seems to move in 'packs' on the highway. Find a safe way to get away from the pack and travel alone. The goal being to maximize the distance around your vehicle.

• Don't follow the taillights of the vehicle ahead – When the snow is so heavy, visibility is low, seeing the taillights of the vehicle ahead, **this means you are following too closely.**

• Keep a safe driving distance back at all times, especially in bad weather. If the leader makes an error, you will too. Trucks can leave the road, and yours could follow the lead truck off the road.

• Use good judgment — If the weather is severe, get off the road. Find a place to get off the road safely and wait until conditions are safe.

• Don't stop on the shoulder of the road — Especially in low visibility situations, when driving in winter, especially 'blinding

snow', other vehicles can mistake your position for being on the road and as a result, may slam into the back of your rig.

• Braking – Some drivers like to use the jake brake in less than perfect weather conditions. Some don't. DO NOT ENGAGE THE JAKE BRAKE ON ICY ROADS. Try to avoid overusing your foot brake, unless the entire unit is absolutely 'straight' on the road. Don't over brake when the entire unit isn't straight, the trailer can slide and spin you out of your position, the truck slows down, and the trailer does not. This is especially true, when the trailer is empty.

• Be certain — Be absolutely certain during your pre-check before you leave, that the defroster and heater are working properly. Wipers, wiper motor, lights, esp. brake and taillights, washer fluid is topped up, all brakes are set up and windows and mirrors are completely clean before departure.

• Keep tractor and trailer lights clean — When you're able to stop in a safe place, clear the lights of snow and ice, which builds up in bad weather. Keep everything clean, so you can BE SEEN.

<u>Remember, Marten Transport is the only carrier that pays</u> you for shutting down due to inclement weather. Nothing is more important than the safety of our drivers.

401(k) Annual Auto Enrollment Period All 401(k) auto enrollment changes will take effect on November 1

Participating in Marten Transport's 401(k) plan is one of the easiest ways to save for retirement! Plus, you'll gain the benefits with the company match of \$.35 on the dollar up to 6% of pay that you contribute! This is free money!

• In order to help our employees secure a better financial future, employees who are not currently participating or those deferring less than 6% will be automatically enrolled. This means if you are eligible and you are contributing less than 6% to the 401(k) plan, you will be automatically enrolled for a pre-tax contribution of 6% of your gross pay. Also, your contribution level will increase by 1% each year until it reaches 15%. These changes will occur on your automatic enrollment date. Look for the Transamerica packet of information in the mail!

Auto enrollment plan changes will take

effect November 1, 2022. For those who don't want to be auto-enrolled or if you would like to change your contribution percent, please contact Transamerica by October 26th at 1-800-755-5801 or log on to www. Transamerica.com/portal.

Marten has updated its accident policy to reflect current prices due to rising inflation. Marten takes safety very seriously which is why Marten invests in electronic logging, our sleep apnea program, collision avoidance systems, grille guards, weather warning alert systems, automatic transmissions, forward facing cameras and lane departure systems. Marten is continually making improvements to make sure drivers make it home safely to their families. Thank you for your dedication and safe driving.



Another safety feature Marten is improving upon is installing disc brakes on all our trucks. Disc brakes allow our trucks to stop 22 feet faster when going 65 mph! Currently, 1,200 trucks have front disc brakes and 224 have both front and rear. These numbers are increasing every month and eventually all Marten trucks will have disc brakes installed.

Blind spot detection has already been installed in 2,400 Marten trucks and by the end of this year, all Marten trucks will have blind spot detection systems installed.

Evaporative "Swamp" Coolers Brought Relief to Shop Spaces



Evaporative coolers, sometimes called swamp coolers, use water evaporation to reduce temperatures without consuming large amounts of energy. This eco-friendly technology allows for fast spot-cooling through lowering of temperatures by as much as 33 °F (18 °C) when Cool-Space evaporative coolers are used.

This summer Marten was able to provide our shops located in the warmer climates, portable evaporative coolers. These gigantic fans are 6 feet tall and use water to deliver cold air into the environment. One cooler can cool half a bay! What a huge difference this has made to our employees.


