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Celebrating a Great Year *Marten continues to navigate down the road to success*

We believed that 2022 would be a simpler year after conquering the challenges seen during the worldwide pandemic. However; the year did come with a few challenges, all of which our people overcame like pros and pushed to ensure that 2022 was filled with many successes. We hit the ground running in January with strong driver recruiting that continued throughout the year. This success set a strong foundation on which to grow our seated tractor count, provide the capacity our customers needed, and expand the freight and lane diversity our drivers desired to give their families a good work/life balance. These efforts provided a boost to net income and commemorate our 15th consecutive quarter of profitable growth.

In 2022, the transportation industry had its fair share of obstacles and challenges, no different than years past. Likewise, what has not changed is the appreciation Marten has for our professional drivers. We continue to focus on creating jobs that lead to more frequency and predictability of home time. We also are proud to stand behind these jobs by providing Minimum Guarantee pay to drivers who work their full week. We know the bumps in the road drivers face, those obstacles should not impact their paychecks. Driver-friendly jobs with industry-leading pay have proven to be a winning combination. The continued efforts to provide driver improvements are reflected in our growth of more than 450 professional drivers.

All of our businesses were successful in 2022. Our Brokerage division grew our carrier base and shipper count by over 50%, which drove terrific load count and revenue growth. Our Intermodal division also added 168 more refrigerated

containers to provide capacity our customers needed. Marten's rail division is gaining momentum to produce even bigger numbers next year.

Our Dedicated division added nine new fleets, two of which were new customers adding 97 additional drivers. On top of that, we added 64 more drivers to 11 of our existing fleets. Both the Coca Cola Dedicated Carrier of the Year and the Chemours Platinum Carrier of the Year honors were won by our team of Dedicated drivers. Our team has won the Chemours Carrier of the Year award for the second vear in a row. "You're the carrier we think of when we need help," said Chemours Global Supply Chain Director, Christopher Young at the award ceremony. In what was expected to be a difficult year in 2021, we transported over 2,600 truckloads over 1.5 million miles with an on-time load percentage of 99.3%. We appreciate not only the drivers of these two specific carriers, but also the drivers of all our dedicated fleets.

Marten's Dry Van Division celebrated another successful year of organic growth and expansion projects throughout the country. We started this division with three trucks in 2016 out of Edwardsville, KS, and now support and operate 350 Dry Van drivers on the road today. We have a Dry Van presence in seven terminals, including Edwardsville, Tucker, Tampa, Phoenix, DeSoto, Laredo, and Otay Mesa. Our largest expansion project executed this year was the inception of our Dry Fleet in Desoto and expanding our operations into Mexico through Laredo and Otay Mesa. We also added several Dry Van dedicated customer accounts to our network internally. Our Dry Van team also won two awards this year, including the Nestle Waters Carrier

of the Year award, which we received out of 67 carriers in the southeastern network. The Five Below New Carrier of the Year is the other award which was made possible by the efforts of our teams in Georgia and Texas.

Our core focus for 2023 will be growing the Dry Van Division organically and profitably. We are determined to operate two additional Dry Van segments based in Memphis, TN and Wilsonville, OR. We are excited about this future growth made possible by our team of empowered employees dedicated to excellence.

Marten is committed to reducing our carbon footprint. In order to accomplish this, we have installed solar panels with APUs on our nationwide fleet of over 33,500 tractors and 15 terminals. As a result of this, Marten remains a top contender in our industry for solar technology. This progress has been monumental for Marten, and we intend to continue pushing for energy sustainability and long-term profitability in the future.

Our top priority has remained constant over the past year. Marten values safety above all else, and we have taken extra precautions this year to ensure it. As of November, 1,203 of our trucks were equipped with front disc brakes, and 303 were equipped with both front and rear disc brakes. At 65 miles per hour, these disc brakes will stop our trucks 22 feet faster, reducing collisions and risk to our drivers. Other significant additions to our trucks include 708 trucks with blind spot detection, bringing the total to 2,521 trucks with this feature, and 431 trucks added with lane departure, bringing the total to 3,502 trucks.

We were recognized as a SmartWay Higher Performer in 2022.

This honor is awarded to multimodal carriers that maximize efficiency by consolidating and optimizing shipments along the most efficient routes.

As Marten has expanded this year, many significant changes have occurred in both new and old facilities. Our terminal in Phoenix, AZ is undergoing many large additions to their operations facility, including a full remodel with much more space for additional workstations. Their driver facility is being renovated, with new restrooms and a driver lounge, as well as two new quiet rooms. Finally, for maintenance, they are currently building a new body/paint shop as well as an automated truck wash.

In Orlando, a new drop yard is being prepared for construction. The land has been purchased, and the site plans are complete and awaiting county approval. At this early stage in the process, completion is expected in the second quarter of 2023.

Finally, our Otay Mesa, CA facility has been completed. To support our future growth, we have built a brand-new terminal with 20 workstations and a fully equipped driver lounge. These changes are just a fraction of what is yet to come.

COMPLETE YOUR CHRA

WHAT'S A CHRA?

UMR's clinical health risk assessment (CHRA) is a series of questions to help you see your current health status. It takes about 20 minutes to complete the questionnaire online.

STEP 1 - CREATE AN ACCOUNT ON UMR.COM

To get started, visit **umr.com** and select **Login/Register**. Choose **Member** from the drop-down menu to register or log in as a member. Enter your username and password, or if it's your first time visiting us, click **Register now** to open an account.

Helpful hints:

- When you register to use your online services for the first time, make sure you have your UMR member ID card handy. You will need your member ID number and group number (no dashes) to enroll, and you can find this information on the front of your ID card.
- Spouses eligible for the program must create their own online member account on umr.com and complete their own CHRA.
- You will need to provide a valid email address when you register. We may use email to send you important information or reminders about your benefits.

Make sure you select a username and password you can remember. You will need these when you log in again in the future. If you can't remember your login information, you can use the "Forgot username or password?" links to recover your username or reset your password.

STEP 2 - COMPLETE YOUR CHRA

After you've successfully logged in to your online services on **umr.com**, you can complete your CHRA at any time that is convenient to you. But remember, you must submit your completed CHRA between **12/01/2022** and **10/31/2023** to participate in the wellness program.

If not completed by 1/31/23, a surcharge will start coming out of your paycheck.

To begin your CHRA:

- 1. Select Take a CHRA from your member home page.
- 2. Select the **Get started!** button from the wellness activity center landing page; if you are not redirected, please check to see if a new tab or page has opened.
- 3. Under Clinical health risk assessment, press the Complete button.
- After answering all the questions in the CHRA, make sure to press Submit. Your CHRA is considered incomplete until it is submitted, and we will be unable to process your results.

Note: You can also complete your CHRA on your mobile device. Simply log in to umr.com, select Health center from the main menu and choose the Wellness activity center button.

When you are done, it's time to view your report. You will also receive the results of your CHRA in the mail about 2 weeks after completing your assessment. Your results will tell you your personal wellness score, health status and risk for developing a disease in the future.

Winter Safety Tips; slips, trips and falls

Reminders for how to stay safe when outside during wintery conditions

No matter how well the ice and snow are removed from surfaces there is still a risk for slipping when walking outdoors. Here are some tips to keep you safe this winter season.

*Assume all wet areas are slippery and icy.

*Avoid wearing boots or shoes with a smooth sole. Instead choose boots that are made with non-slip rubber or neoprene with grooved soles.

*Use your 3-point contact when exiting your truck and do not break contact until you have reached the ground. *Walk along the grassy edge if sidewalks are slippery.

*Walk slowly and with small steps.

*Point your feet out slightly, while bending at the waist. Keep your hands out of your pockets and out to your side. This will increase your center of gravity.

*If you feel like you are falling, try to relax your muscles and fall towards your side. This will avoid injury to the knees, wrist, and spine.

*When entering buildings remove snow and water from your shoes so you do not slip.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Randolph L. Marten Scholarships

Marten Transport has established a scholarship program to assist employee's children who plan to pursue post-secondary education programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at any accredited post-secondary institution of the student's choice.

Eligibility: Applicants must be dependent* children 23 and under, (up to age 24) of full-time Marten Transport Ltd. Employees who have a minimum of one year employment with the company as of the application date. *Dependent children are defined as natural and legally adopted children or stepchildren living in the employee's household or primarily supported by the employee.

Applicants must be high school seniors or graduates who plan to enroll or students who are already enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.
