## **SUSTAINABILITY INITIATIVES**

Marten reduces overall mileage via internal equipment changes, temperature initiatives, network restructuring, and multimodal carrier conversions from truckload to intermodal- reducing carbon footprint by more than 60% per load. Marten has created the Loading Warm & Reefer Run initiative using temperature technology to educate customers and reduce reefer usage. Marten has added solar panels at all 14 terminals and on tractors, has converted all lighting to LED, and has installed a lithium battery bank at its Jurupa Valley, California terminal.

## **NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENT**

Marten has made the Smartway High Performance list year after year for improving freight efficiency and Inbound Logistics top 75 carriers for supply chain sustainability commitment. The company has also been awarded *Energy Efficient Leader* from Thermo King and the most *Progressive Carrier of the Year* from Coca-Cola.



Marten's average fuel burn during drivers 10 hr break



## Rail Conversion

Rail is the most environmentally efficient mode of surface transportation and many of Marten's customers recognize it as an effective way to reduce carbon emissions



In 2022, BNSF customers reduce their total carbon emissions by 23.9 million metric tons. That's the equivalent of taking 5.2 million vehicles off the road.\*



On average, BNSF trains move one ton of freight nearly **500 miles** on just one gallon of diesel fuel.\*



On average, trains are **three to four times more fuel efficient** than their highway counterparts and lower greenhouse gas emissions by more than 75%.\*\*



If 25% of truck traffic moving at least 750 miles went by rail instead, annual greenhouse gas emissions would fall by 13.1 million tons.\*\*

#### **MARTEN'S USED OIL:**

Safety-Kleen offers Marten a program unique to the lubricant industry, designed to help manage oil needs in a more sustainable way. *The result is greater efficiencies, guaranteed sustainable processing and a direct reduction in GHG emissions.* 


Safety-Kleens re-refining process requires as much as 80% less energy to produce reclaimed oil than to refine oil from crude. Just one gallon of recovered motor oil produces the same amount of engine oil as 42 gallons of crude. Re-refining is simply a better way to manage used oil, thereby reducing the impact on the environment.


#### **MARTEN'S USED OIL FILTERS:**

As part of the Safety-Kleen organization, Oil Filter Recyclers, Inc. (OFR), is the largest used oil filter collector and recycler in the United States. *One hundred percent of the waste material collected is recycled* thus eliminating Marten's exposure to future environmental risk.

OFR's patented two-phase recycling process separates the used oil filters into three principle products: ferrous metals, filter media and used oil. All of these are reused in various manufacturing processes or as alternative fuels.






# **MILLION MILE**
